On behalf of SKE Pissouriou, we would like to express our sincere appreciation for the opportunity to participate in the Erasmus+ Youth Exchange “**Empowerment through Creative Arts and Participation for European Teens (ECAPT)**” 2025-1-AT01-KA152-YOU-000297832, implemented in Vienna, Austria.

For our organisation, the project was an extremely valuable educational and intercultural experience, both for the facilitating team from Cyprus and for the group of students who participated actively throughout all phases of the project.

1) Preparation and organisational process
